

BYLAW 375/99
OF THE
VILLAGE OF GLENDON

A By-Law of the Municipal Council of the Village of Glendon
in the Province of Alberta to Establish Fees Payable by a Person
or Persons Appealing Their Assessment.

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta and under the provisions of Section 481 thereof, the Council of the Village of Glendon enacts as follows:

Whereas, the Council of the Village of Glendon deems it expedient to implement charges for processing assessment appeals.

Therefore, the Council of the Village of Glendon enacts as follows:

- Any person or persons filing an appeal or individual as a party or intervener in a hearing before an assessment review board and for obtaining copies of an assessment review board's decision and other documents will be assessed the following fees:

- A residential property \$ 25.00
- A non - residential property \$ 50.00

and Whereas, if the person or persons win their assessment appeal, they will be granted back their fees.
