### Bylaw #431-13

#### OF THE VILLAGE OF GLENDON

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF GLENDON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE FOR THE POSITION OF CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL BEING APPOINTED FROM AMONG THE COUNCILLORS AND REPEAL BYLAW 367-96.

WHEREAS it is provide in and by the MGA, Chapter M-26, Part 5 Division 2 Section 150(2) and, that the chief elected official of a village, summer village or municipal district is to be appointed by council for among the councillors unless the council passes a bylaw providing that the official is to be elected by a vote of the electors of the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Council of the Village of Glendon, repeal bylaw 367-96.

- (a) Village "shall mean the Municipal Corporation of the Village of Glendon, Alberta
- (b) Chief Elected Official" means the person appointed as chief elected official under section 150
- (c) "Council" means the council of the Village of Glendon, Alberta
- (d) "Councillor" includes the chief elected official

## SECTION 3 APPIONTMENT OF CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL

The chief elected official of the Village of Glendon, is to be appointed by council from among the councillors.
