MOST Grant

Res: 2268/21 Moved by Mayor Papirny that the Village of Glendon established a COVID-19 Assistance Program for businesses located within the Village of Glendon, with the purpose of the program being to provide financial assistance to help offset some of the costs and loss of revenue that have been incurred by local businesses during the pandemic. Storefront businesses are eligible to apply for up to a \$500.00 grant and home-based businesses may apply for up to a \$100.00 grant. To be eligible for the program the following conditions must be met:

Must hold a 2021 Village of Glendon business license.

Must be located within the Village of Glendon.

Must be current on property taxes.

Must not be a Council member, employee, or immediate family of either a Council member or employee (immediate family member includes spouse and children).

Must have provided product and/or services to the public after March 15, 2020.



Must have incurred expenses to meet the COVID-19 guidelines and/or be able to demonstrate a loss of revenue.
