**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Glendon Drainage Parkway**

A discussion was held with Mr. Engman regarding the proposed Glendon Drainage Parkway. The process of obtaining approval for a Water Diversion was explained by Mr. Engman. They are in the process of completing the application at this time. No work on the Drainage Parkway will be started before all approvals are in place. The time frame for obtaining the approval could be up to two years. The work that can be started is work for the walking trail, for which no approval is required from Alberta Environment.

Councilor Scott Lundgren declared a conflict of interest and left the meeting at 7:36 P.M.

Res: 1655/19 Moved by Councilor Nicholas Werstiuk that the Village of Glendon proceed with the Drainage Parkway Tree Clearing so that the walking trail can be constructed and that the walking trail go ahead as planned, with the exception that no chain link fences will be installed until the drainage parkway itself is completed and that no benches are installed as part of this project.
